Please note: If you are sharing space, each vendor is required to submit a signed completed application and all applications must be received together. On the top each application submitted, the following should be noted: "SHARING SPACE WITH *insert name of vendor(s)* Submitting an application is not guarantee that your business will be chosen to vend at our event. We are trying to avoid duplication of like businesses to help the vendors all sell better. Also, if you carry your own insurance, be sure to include that with your application.

Booth space is 10'x10'. This event is completely outside. You will need to bring your own popup tent or sunshade to provide shade, though there is some tree shade. Please stay within the 10X10 space guidelines. AV Pagan Pride does not provide tables or chairs, you will need to bring everything you need for vending. You will also need to bring weights to secure your sunshade as it can be QUITE windy in the Antelope Valley. No stakes are allowed at this park. Also, the park has a no dogs policy.

Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. You may elect a section preference, but we do not guarantee you will be assigned your first choice. Space assignments will be based according to date application & payment received, date payment clears, and how each section/row is filled.

Vendor Fee: \$40 plus a donation item to our raffle (if received before August 15th, 2016). \$50 plus donation item to our raffle (after August 15th, 2016).

Our deadline for vending applications is August 27th, 2016. No applications will be accepted after that date.

Each individual sharing the booth is asked to donate a \$20 value item to our raffle; however, only one fee will be assessed per booth.

Vendor fee is not tax deductible, however, any amount over \$75 or any additional donation items received will be tax deductible and a receipt will be provided upon request. Any additional monies or donation items above what are required are also greatly appreciated.
